TURF TALK

Chris Durkee, GC Superintendent

The dog days of summer are certainly over and you have no doubt noticed it taking effects around the golf course. With record setting heat waves and persistent drought throughout the Southeast, we have certainly had a tough time getting enough water on the ground to keep the course on it's healthy progression. We have invested a lot of time and resources in updating our aging pump station and soon it will be operating more efficiently and effectively than ever before.



You may recall that the entire vertical pump was removed, rebuilt and replaced in June. This gave us a much more efficient main unit to power the system and maintain optimum pressure at or around 90 psi. In the next few weeks, both the 25hp discharge pipe and the 60hp discharge pipe both developed leaks and replacements needed to be custom built and reinstalled. While performing these repairs, we also replaced the shaft seals in the 60hp pump which should make a nice improvement to its performance as well.

As we speak, all three pumps are operating normally, however, for the past three weeks we have been dealing with computer issues in our main control panel. Basically, we lost the ability for the computer to turn on a pump automatically. The pumps will only run if they

BEAUTIFICATION UPDATE

Beautification projects will be decided at the October tennis committee. Approximately \$5,000 has been earmarked. Top considerations are repairing broken and rusted fence lines and replacing rusted net posts. Improvements in these areas should start by the end of the year. The tennis membership will be updated as these projects get under way.

POLICY AND PROCEDURES REVIEW

Below, please find the most common areas of concern regarding the tennis facility. If you have any questions, please let us know.

1. Guest Policy- Sport and Full members have free use of the courts. Social members and guests pay a \$10 per person court usage fee. If you bring a guest, please sign in at the green sign-in area in the walkway to the right of the tennis shop front door. Look for the, "All members and guests: Please sign in" signage.
2. In order to play on an adult Selva Tennis Team you must be a Full, Sport or Team member.
3. Adult ladies' clinics are open to Selva members only. A guest may try one or two clinics if they are interested in joining the Club or if they live out of town and are the guest of a member.
4. Private lessons are open to non-members as long as it does not interfere with a member's preferred lesson time.
5. Junior clinics and the USTA Youth Team Tennis League are open to non-members at a higher rate than members.
6. Proper tennis attire and flat-soled shoes must be worn at all times. Sleeveless tennis shirts for men are not considered proper attire.
